## HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP) helps with heating costs, electric costs, and energy crisis situations. Through Baraga Electric Utility's participation in this program, you may be eligible for bill pay assistance.

Eligibility for MEAP benefits is based on a number of factors. However, if the gross annual income for your household is less than the amount shown below, you may be eligible to receive assistance.
